

Full Time – Plumber (37.5 hours per week)

Main Purpose of Job:

To work as a member of the maintenance team to undertake repairs and preventative maintenance in all facilities. Ensure that all plumbing facilities are suitably maintained and recommend / undertake any necessary improvements.

Main Duties & Key Responsibilities:

- 1. To work as a member of the maintenance team to ensure that all facilities are maintained to a high standard.
- 2. To carry out new installation works and emergency repairs as required to a high level of workmanship.
- 3. To service and repair all types of plumbing equipment and take a lead on all heating equipment.
- 4. To service, install, commission, repair main items of plant.
- 5. To assist in the Planned Preventative Maintenance programme to ensure high efficiencies on plant are maintained.
- 6. To assist in the training of Site Personnel in the safe operation of plant and equipment.
- 7. To liaise with contractors to ensure all pluming works meet Regulations.
- 8. Be responsible for the plumbing & heating operation of the stadium on match days.
- 9. To ensure that all water testing is undertaken by external contractors in accordance with regulations.
- 10. Develop positive working relationships with both external suppliers & contractors.
- 11. To comply with all relevant Health and Safety legislation and guidance.
- 12. Carry out such other duties that may from time to time arise, develop or be assigned and that are consistent with the grade of the job.
