Half Term Curriculum Overview

Year 5/6 Spring 2

English

- We follow The Write Stuff to support English teaching at the Regis Academy.
- The Write Stuff is based on two guiding principles; teaching sequences that slide between experience days and sentence stacking lessons. With modelling at the heart of them, the sentence stacking lessons are broken into bite-sized chunks and taught under the structural framework of The Writing Rainbow. Teachers prepare children for writing by modelling the ideas, grammar or techniques of writing.

Physical Education

PE will vary between sports, games and skills

Topic

- How the Vikings changed life in England.
- Understand who King Alfred the Great was.
- Understand how the Viking age came to an end and the significance of Willian the Conqueror.
- Children will create Viking settlements as part of their DT project.

Mathematics

- We follow the White Rose Maths scheme at Regis Academy.
- This half term, we will be focusing on measure, ratio, perimeter, area and volume.
- Children also complete Fluent in Five questions at the start of each Maths lesson to revise and recap basic skills.

RE

- Children will study how religions can help when times get hard.
- They will describe at least three examples of ways in which religions guide people in how to respond to good and hard times in life.

Spanish

- Children will learn how to introduce themselves and say their age.
- They will also learn the moths of the year and their birthday in Spanish.

Science

- Children will also spend time learning about solids, liquids and gases.
- They will also learn about different changes in state, including reversible and irreversible changes.

Computing

- In computing, we will be using LEGO to learn about programming. Pupils will get to follow instructions to create moveable machines and tools with LEGO.
