

# Half Term Curriculum Overview

## Year 5/6 Summer 1

### English

- We follow The Write Stuff to support English teaching at the Regis Academy.
- The Write Stuff is based on two guiding principles; teaching sequences that slide between experience days and sentence stacking lessons. With modelling at the heart of them, the sentence stacking lessons are broken into bite-sized chunks and taught under the structural framework of The Writing Rainbow. Teachers prepare children for writing by modelling the ideas, grammar or techniques of writing.

### History

- The chronological order of Kings and Queens
- How to demonstrate an understanding of the various significant British Kings and Queens, such as Richard III, Elizabeth I and Queen Victoria
- How to recall some key facts about different monarchs and make comparisons between the lives of Elizabeth I and Queen Victoria



### Mathematics

- Children will investigate statistics and properties of shape.
- Children in Year 6 will also complete their SATs in this half term.
- Following SATs, children will consolidate their learning.

### Physical Education

- Children will focus on temptation; they will look at how different religions view temptation, exploring their understanding of good and evil.
