We have a robust girl's football pathway, consisting of Player Development Centre/Academy's for girls aged 6 - 16 years old, regular half term camp provision and U10s, U11s, & U12s team competing in the Central Warwickshire girls league on a weekly basis. Within this set up, our programmes have a close link with West Bromwich Albion RTC for player transition month and the Elite Development League for professional club fixtures during half term.

Alongside football delivery and pathways, we hope the candidates have classroom experience to plan and deliver PL Changemakers 12-week female leadership course.

We hope the new recruits can expand our current delivery and create a larger offer in Sandwell boroughs surround West Bromwich Albion FC.
