Job Purpose		

To coordinate and promote sessions primarily for females within the local community of West Bromwich Albion FC in the Sandwell borough.

This will include planning, monitoring and evaluation of sessions and activities. This is to help grow, maintain and enhance the quality of the provision on offer for females.

The successful candidate will implement a mix of new and existing programmes, working primarily with females and lead on programmes to embed leadership qualities and physical exercise.

Duties and responsibilities

- To be accountable for the growth of Female provision within the Community, funded by Premier League Kicks, Premier League Inspires, Premier League Changemakers and any other female specific funds.
- To develop and deliver high quality 12-week Female Leadership courses (PL Changemakers) and provide a smooth transition into voluntary or playing pathways.
- To deliver high quality football activities and alternative sports to widen the female community offer to increase playing opportunities.
- To be accountable for the training, recruitment, development and team management of The Albion Foundations Casual Female football coaches.
- Identify and transition talented female players to join the most appropriate session within the girl's playing pathway.
- To work where possible with the Girls Football Lead and Casual Girls Football coaches to develop and embed a transparent playing pathway appropriate for all abilities. For Example, Premier League Kicks girls' football, Player Development Centres and Central Warwickshire Girls football League teams.
- To work with the Kicks Manager to establish new, innovative methods to engage and sustain young females. For example, Camps, school festivals, individual development plan training sessions and school leadership courses.

General

- Ensure the Women & Girls department compliments strategically and operationally West Bromwich Albion Football Club and The Albion Foundation.
- Work with schools, colleges and University to develop further initiatives and opportunities across curriculum and beyond.
- Develop resources that support professional development of staff within the Foundation and participants of the programme where necessary.
- To be able to work flexible and unsociable hours where the role of the job requires.
- Any other duties as commensurate with post holder's role and abilities.
