

Half Term Curriculum Overview

Year 5/6 Autumn 1

English

- We follow The Write Stuff to support English teaching at the Regis Academy.
- The Write Stuff is based on two guiding principles; teaching sequences that slide between experience days and sentence stacking lessons. With modelling at the heart of them, the sentence stacking lessons are broken into bite-sized chunks and taught under the structural framework of The Writing Rainbow. Teachers prepare children for writing by modelling the ideas, grammar or techniques of writing.

Topic

- How the Black Country flag represents the Black Country and explain how it got its name.
- Know where the Black Country is and be able to locate it on a map of Great Britain.
- Identify key physical and human features such as hills within the local area.
- Locate significant towns within the Black Country.



Mathematics

- Children will explore place value, including decimals.
- Children will also develop their understanding of the 4 main operations (addition, subtraction, multiplication and division).
- White Rose will be utilised to support the teaching of mathematics.

Physical Education

RE

- Know simple examples of religious and cultural diversity in their local area
- Compare their ideas about respect for all with those studied
- Explain beliefs about the value of religious and cultural diversity in their local community

DT

- Children will study a local artist and create sculptures using clay.

Science

- Children will learn about living things and their habitats.
- They will also learn about classification and how this can be a tool to organise animals and plants.

Computing

- Children will be using Scratch to design and code their own interactive game. This will include making backgrounds and characters.
- Online safety - writing rules for safe use of the internet and understanding our responsibilities online in relation to our digital footprint.
