

Half Term Curriculum Overview

Year 5/6 Summer 2

English

- We follow The Write Stuff to support English teaching at the Regis Academy.
- The Write Stuff is based on two guiding principles; teaching sequences that slide between experience days and sentence stacking lessons. With modelling at the heart of them, the sentence stacking lessons are broken into bite-sized chunks and taught under the structural framework of The Writing Rainbow. Teachers prepare children for writing by modelling the ideas, grammar or techniques of writing.

Physical Education

- PE will vary between sports, games and skills

DT

- Children will study fashionable design in this era. They will use this to design a model bedroom on the ship depending on the class system they have chosen.

History

- Children will study titanic and its significance in history.
- Will explore the class systems to help us understand the society during this time.
- Children will explore the course of the ship through map skills (longitude and latitude) and identify where the ship sunk.
- Understand safety advancement this disaster has on our lives today.



Science

- Children will learn about living things and their habitats.
- This will involve life process including sexual and asexual reproduction.
- Children will classify living things based on specific characteristics.

Mathematics

- Children will spend time after their SATs consolidating skills learnt during Key Stage Two in preparation for secondary school.

RE

- Children will spend time looking at Christianity. They will focus on Jesus and how he guides them to live better lives.

Computing

In this unit, the pupils research examples of art gallery architecture, before using Trimble SketchUp to create their own virtual gallery. Finally, they use the gallery to exhibit their own artwork.
