
We are seeking to appoint a Community Coach who can deliver high quality sessions that will add value to our current delivery models.

The advertised salary is based upon an equivalent hourly rate of £9.50 p/h. With effect from 1st April 2023, the equivalent hourly rate will increase to a minimum of £10.42 p/h. For an employee working 37.5 hours per week this equates to an annual salary of £18,525.00 - and which would increase to £20,319.00 from 1st April 2023
