Privacy Notice

West Bromwich Albion Football Club Limited (the **Club**) is keen to identify new playing and coaching talent and works with a number of talent scouts and scouting information service providers to support the initiative.

The Club may not always receive contact details for each person at the time we receive information about them or it may involve a disproportionate effort to try to find contact details for every person. In these cases, a Privacy Notice being provided directly to each individual, may not be feasible, but the detail in this Privacy Notice can be accessed from our website Privacy Policy.

This Privacy Notice explains how the Club uses and protects your personal data, as well as your rights in respect of it, how to exercise your rights and how to contact us. If you provide information to us about any other people, you must give them a copy of this Privacy Notice so that they understand how their information will be used. You should only provide information about them if you are authorised to do so.

Categories of personal data that we process

We process the following types of personal data for our purposes and the Club is the controller of this data.

Name, age and contact details

Information about your skills and experience in football and other sports including:

- scouting reports
- appearances, goals, assists, passing, offensive and defensive duels, finishing, goals, chance creation, ball
 progression, build up play, tackles, fouls, disciplinary record, position(s), clubs played for, left or right footed,
 height
- speed, high intensity actions, accelerations, distance covered, sprint distance

Injuries

Images

Social media use, entries, images and comments

Other media features and commentary

Nationality, previous clubs and governing body endorsement points achieved (where applicable)

Sources of personal data

We obtain information from:

- talent scouts and scouting data providers, the media, coaches and match officials
- third party data providers
- social media accounts
- the media
- you, agents, representatives and family members
- football governing bodies, football leagues and other clubs

Automated decisions using personal data

We do not normally take any solely automated decisions.

Purposes for which we process personal data and the legal basis for doing so

We process personal data for a number of purposes, which are:

Where you have given your consent to any processing of personal data, you have the right to withdraw that consent at any time. If you do, it will not affect the lawfulness of any processing for which we had consent prior to your withdrawing it.

Who we may disclose your personal data to

You Scouts Complainants Insurers Legal and other professional advisers Regulators Courts or tribunals Police and other law enforcement agencies Government agencies *(where we have a legal obligation to do so)* Relevant service providers that provide services to the Club Football governing bodies, authorities and football leagues Other clubs

Location of your personal data

In most cases, we normally keep your personal data within the United Kingdom

Wherever we transfer your personal data outside of the United Kingdom, we will take proper care to ensure that it is protected in accordance with this Privacy Notice and applicable privacy laws.

Where we use service providers that provide their services in countries that are not deemed to have an adequate level of protection for personal data, we will normally use the United Kingdom approved 'Standard Contractual Clauses' as the legally accepted mechanism to allow the transfer and protect your data protection rights.

How long we keep your personal data for

The duration for which we keep personal data depends on your relationship with us. The normal expectation is detailed below.

General records	Safeguarding
Normally for 6 years after you cease to be involved with the Club or 6 years after our last contact with you or 6 years after we have taken an interest in you as a prospective player <i>(whichever is longer)</i>	Concerns about Children: until the individual reaches the age of 25 unless there is a legitimate basis to retain it for longer Adult Records: until the individual reaches their normal retirement age or for 10 years (whichever is longer) unless there is a legitimate basis to retain it for longer Malicious allegations: immediate deletion unless there is a legitimate basis to retain it for longer

After this time period we will securely delete your personal data or anonymise / pseudonymise it unless we have a legal basis for keeping it.

In the unlikely event that there is a complaint or incident which involves or affects you, we may keep your personal data for 6 years after the matter is resolved.

Your legal rights in respect of your personal data

You have a number of legal rights over your personal data which are:

Right	Explanation
access	You have the right to receive a copy of the personal data that we hold about you. We will need proof of identity and proof of authority if the request comes from someone other than you. This will ensure we only provide information to the correct person.
withdraw consent to direct marketing	You can exercise this right at any time. Just send an email to <u>dataprotection@wbafc.co.uk</u> and we will take care of this for you.
withdraw consent to other processing.	Where the only legal basis for our processing your personal data is that we have your consent, you can withdraw that consent at any time, and we will have to stop processing your personal data. Please note, this does not mean that processing carried out before you withdrew your consent is unlawful.
rectification	If you think any of the personal data we hold about you is inaccurate – please contact us at <u>dataprotection@wbafc.co.uk</u> and we will check and, if necessary, amend our records.
restriction	In limited circumstances you may be able to require us to restrict our processing of your personal data. For example, if you think what we hold is inaccurate and we disagree, we may restrict what we do with your personal data until the accuracy has been verified.
erasure	In some circumstances, for example, where we have no legal basis for keeping your personal data, you may be entitled to require us to delete it.
objection	Where our processing is based on it being in our legitimate interests, you may be entitled to object to us processing it.
portability	Where you have provided personal data to us electronically, you may be entitled to require us to provide that data to you electronically or to transmit it to someone else.
complain	If you have any concerns or complaints about how we are handling your personal data we would prefer you to get in touch with us directly so that we can try to resolve the You can also contact the Information Commissioner's Office at <u>www.ico.org.uk</u> .

Some of these legal rights are subject to exceptions which means that we may be entitled, or required, to refuse to comply with a request
