ELLAND ROAD

Leeds United Football Club have called Elland Road home since 1919, although the football ground itself has been in the heart of the West Yorkshire since 1897.

Originally called 'Leeds City', the club reformed as 'United' as a result of being forcibly broken up by the Football Association. The Leeds United stadium boasts four stands: The Revie Stand (North), The Hesco Stand (East), The Elland Road Stand (South), and The John Charles Stand (West).

On your visit, you will be housed in the South End of the John Charles West Stand. When approaching the stand, head towards Entrances 1 & 2 and/or Howards Bar Entrance. Supporters who have tickets in the designated accessible seating areas and wheelchair positions, can enter the ground through the West Stand gates off Elland Road, to access the stadium via a ramp at Exit W1 Gate.

Reminder to Fans

When attending Elland Road please remember to behave responsibly and adhere to the following requirements:

- Do not throw any object onto the pitch
- Do not use offensive language or behave in an inappropriate manner
- Do not encroach onto the pitch
- Do not have flares, fireworks or offensive weapons in your possession.

In line with Ground Regulations visiting supporters can expect to be searched prior to entry and rejected entry or ejected from the ground if the terms and conditions of entry are breached.

By Car

The Leeds United stadium is adjacent to the intersections of the M1, M62 and M621.

If you are travelling from the North please use: A1, M1, A639 to Leeds. Join M621 to Junction 1. Take A6110 from Roundabout into Elland Road.

If you are travelling from the South please use : M1, M621 to Junction 1. Take A6110 from Roundabout into Elland Road.

If you are travelling from the East please use: A64, A1, then as from North or M62, M621 to Junction 1. Take A6110 from the roundabout into Elland Road.

If you are travelling from the West please use: M62, M621, to Junction 1. Take A6110 from the roundabout into Elland Road.

Parking

When visiting Elland Road, there are a number of parking facilities available.

Visiting supporters can use the park and ride car park off Bobby Collins Way, which is located near the official away coaches departure point. The car parks around the stadium are managed by Leeds City Council. If you have any queries, we recommend contacting the council on 0113 395 7400 or via email parcs@leeds.gov.uk. The current prices for match days can be found below:

Cars - £6

Mini coaches - £12

Coaches - £20

We recommend bringing both cash and card payments, as the accepted payment method is at the discretion of the council. Please note that street parking is restricted due to resident permits and parking cannot be pre-booked.

If you are a blue badge holder, please use the first two rows in the car park in Fullerton, off Elland Road. Upon displaying a blue badge no payment will be required.

By Bus

Supporters can take advantage of the matchday shuttle bus service operated by First Leeds Buses that runs in frequent intervals (numbered R2). This service departs 90 minutes before kick-off from Sovereign Street, adjacent to Leeds Railway Station.

After the final whistle, the service will operate back to the city centre. Prices can be found below:

Adults - £3 return or £2 single

Children & Seniors - £1.50 return or £1 single.

Alternatively, supporters can catch the regional bus services: numbers 51 / 52 / 55 from Leeds city centre which stop outside of the Elland Road stadium. However, please note that service is suspended one hour before kick off and one hour after the final whistle.

By Train

The closest railway station to the stadium is Leeds Railway Station [LDS] - New Station Street, Leeds, LS1 4DY. The railway station is located two miles from the stadium, with public and private transport options available to Elland Road (please see the 'By Bus' section).

Concourse

Once you are in the concourse, there are a variety of food and drink kiosks providing a range of pies, hot food, hot and cold drinks. Elland Road is a cashless stadium, please be advised to pay by card or contactless during your visit.

Need to bring your own medication or specific food/drink items? The club asks that visiting supporters email disabledinfo@leedsunited.com to gain an exemption letter to ensure there are no issues during your visit.

Matchday Programme

If you wish to get your hands on a Matchday Programme, payment is by cash only. Programmes are priced at £3.50 and can be purchased from programme sellers who are located in and around the John Charles Stand.

Special Assistance Team

Match Commentary

Supporters who require audio descriptive commentary can pre-book headsets by contacting the Disabled Liaison Officer via disabled.info@leedsunited.com prior to their visit. Please note to utilise this service, card details will be saved onto your account to act as a deposit of £20. All headsets will be delivered and collected from your seat by a wellbeing officer who will be identifiable in a maroon HI visual vest.

Do you require Step Free Access?

Elland Road offers a 'wheelchair taxi service' to navigate supporters in and around the stadium. We recommend pre-booking this service via wellbeing@leedsunited.com.

Supporters can also request to have access to the wheelchair bay platform within the west stand. The platform is elevated to ensure full visibility of the pitch.

Toilets Facilities

Accessible Toilets:

The stadium offers accessible toilets within the John Charles Stand that are fitted with RADAR locks. Supporters can use their own key to access the toilets or ask for a key from a nearby wellbeing officer who will be identifiable in a maroon HI visual vest.

Changing Places Facility:
