You will drive and nurture a positive culture within the training group. Be a coach who makes the Girls Games Programme (GGP) a place where players learn, have fun and develop a love for the game.

You will support the age group coach in delivering football coaching sessions in line with the GGP curriculum/blueprint and be responsible for delivering football coaching sessions.

You will be an advocate and guardian of the women's game.

### AS A GGP LEAD COACH YOU WILL:

- Deliver high quality football coaching sessions to develop all players within your age group, with support of the Lead coach.
- Implement sessions in-line with the club's methodology, player development curriculum, recognise vision and philosophy, and what is suitable for the players.
- Work collaboratively with a multidisciplinary team, including the support coach, strength and conditioning coach, physio and GK coach.
- Continuously seek alternative ways to develop players holistically, as players but more importantly as people.
- Be responsible for all fixture confirmation, officials, securing of home ground, liaising with home ground regarding match day arrangements, payment of officials
- Lead on the planning, preparation, delivery and evaluation of coaching sessions.
- Liaise with other age group coaches around best practise, players going through age group transitions etc.
- Share views and opinions on players development in an open minded and positive way.
- Work across age groups where possible.
