AS A GIRLS GAMES PROGRAMME LEAD COACH YOU WILL:

- Deliver high quality football coaching sessions to develop all players within your age group, utilising the support coach effectively wherever possible.
- Implement sessions in-line with club methodology within our payer development curriculum, and recognise vision and philosophy, and what is suitable for the players.
- Work collaboratively with a multidisciplinary team, including the Lead coach, strength and conditioning coach, physio and GK coach.
- Continuously seek alternative ways to develop players holistically, as players but more importantly as people.
- Support the Club secretary in responsibility for all fixture confirmation, training ground bookings, transport arrangements, officials, securing of home ground, liaising with home ground regarding match day arrangements, securing turnstile operators, payment of officials
- Plan, prepare, deliver and evaluate coaching sessions, following a training programme typically devised by the Player Development Lead.
- Provide input to the development and ongoing improvement/adaptation
 of the coaching curriculum.
