



You are signing up to the Tour De Midlands cycle challenge. By signing up, you agree to participate in the event subject to these terms and conditions.

- Participants enter at their own risk. We will not be liable for any injury or loss that might occur.
- Participants need to be physically fit to take part in the event. You will need to declare to The Albion Foundation if you have any medical needs. If you do have any medical needs, you will need sign off from your doctor to take part.
- We encourage each participant to get medical advice from a GP prior to taking part in the event.
- Emergency contact details to be sent to The Albion Foundation prior to the event.
- By taking part in the event, you are happy with your photograph to be taken and used by the Foundations of Aston Villa, Birmingham City, The Albion Foundation, Walsall and Wolves.
- You will agree to abide by the rules of the Highway Code/Road Safety Laws and follow advice from lead riders and the event organiser to ensure a safe event. You may be taken off the ride if you are not adhering to the Highway Code/Road Safety Laws.
- You will need to provide your own bike for this event. You can ride any roadworthy bike. Electric bikes will be permitted but it must have a maximum continuous motor power of 250W, a pedal assist speed limit of 15.5 mph (25 km/h), and pedals that propel the bike
- You confirm that your bike is in a roadworthy condition, in good repair and suitable to use for this event. Helmets must be worn at all times.
- If the event is to be cancelled due to unforeseen circumstances (including weather), we will work to secure a new date within one year of the original date. If you are unable to attend on the new date, we will compensate you.
- If you cancel or pull out of the event on your own terms within 8 weeks of the event, the registration fee will be non-refundable. If you cancel and pull out with a doctor's note, we will compensate you.
- You will raise a minimum of £150.
- If you pull out of the event, you will need to adhere to the Fundraising Regulators' rules. Whereby you will need to make all your donors aware that you are no longer taking part in the event. You must give them the option of a refund or allow your chosen Foundation to keep the donation.
