- Work closely with the Community Engagement Manager to launch new youth sessions utilising new funding streams to address local need.

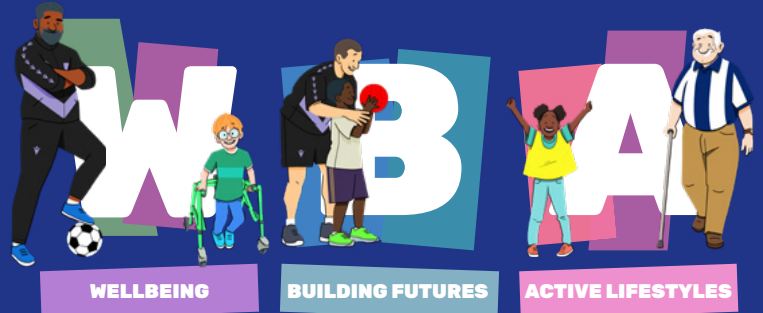
