AS A U16 GGP CO-COACH YOU WILL:

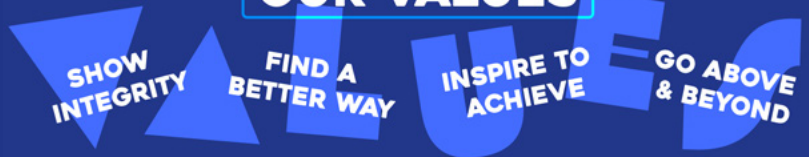

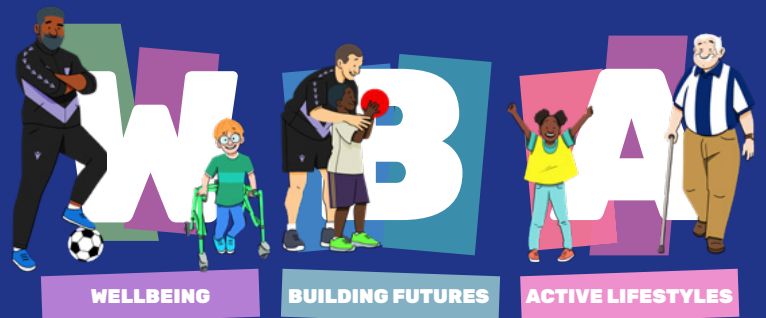
